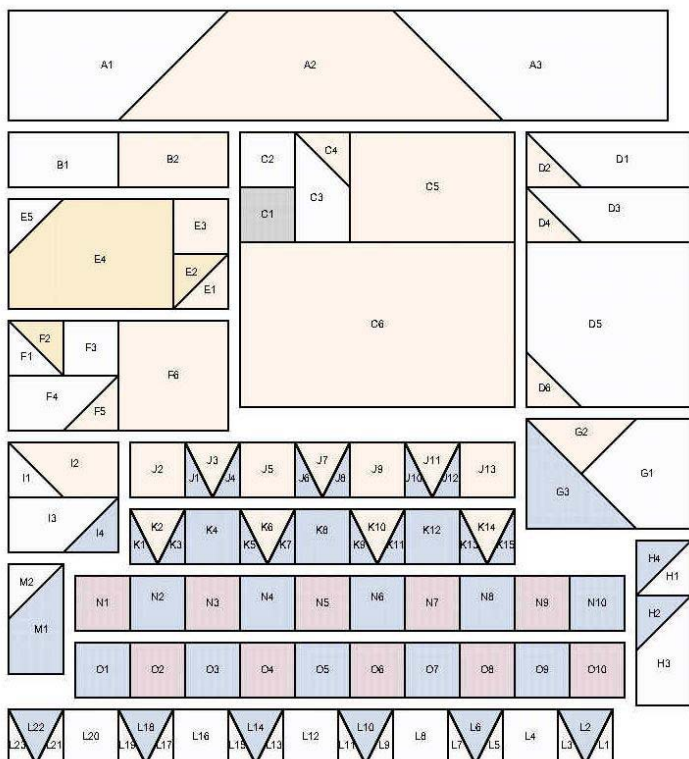
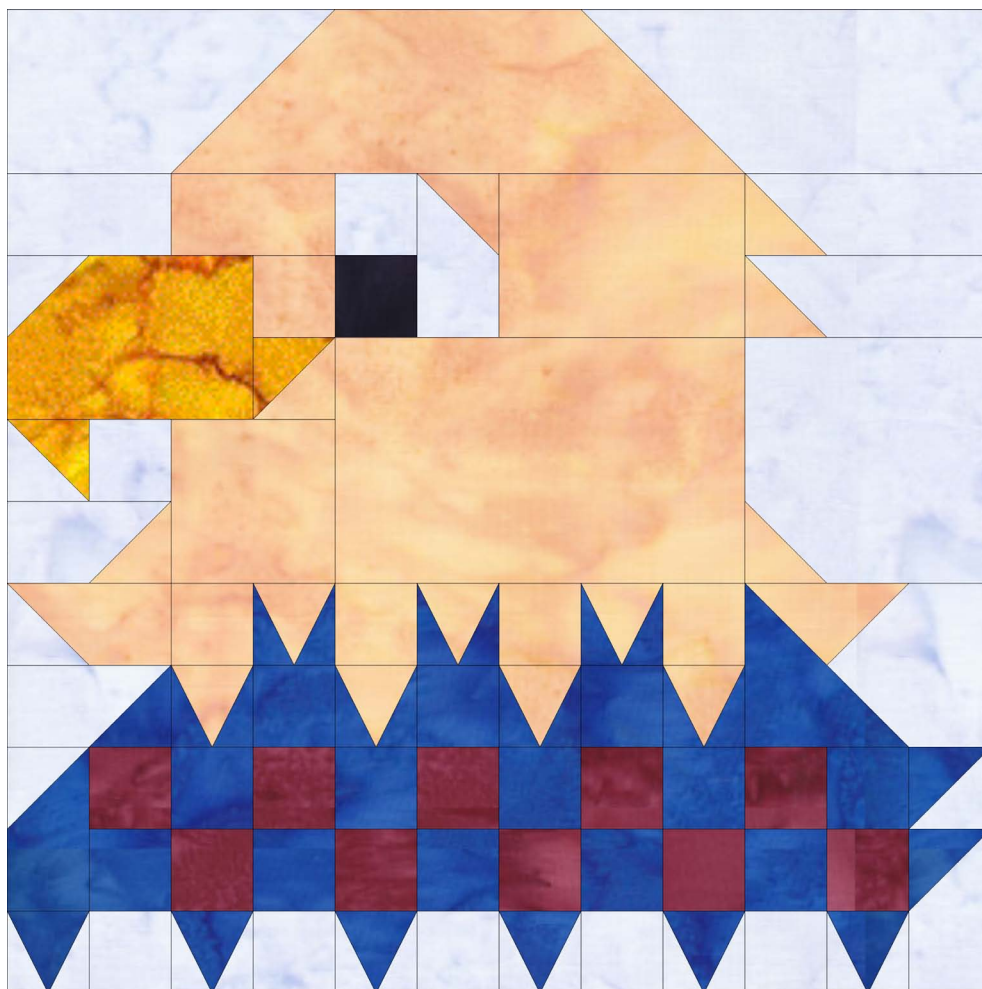

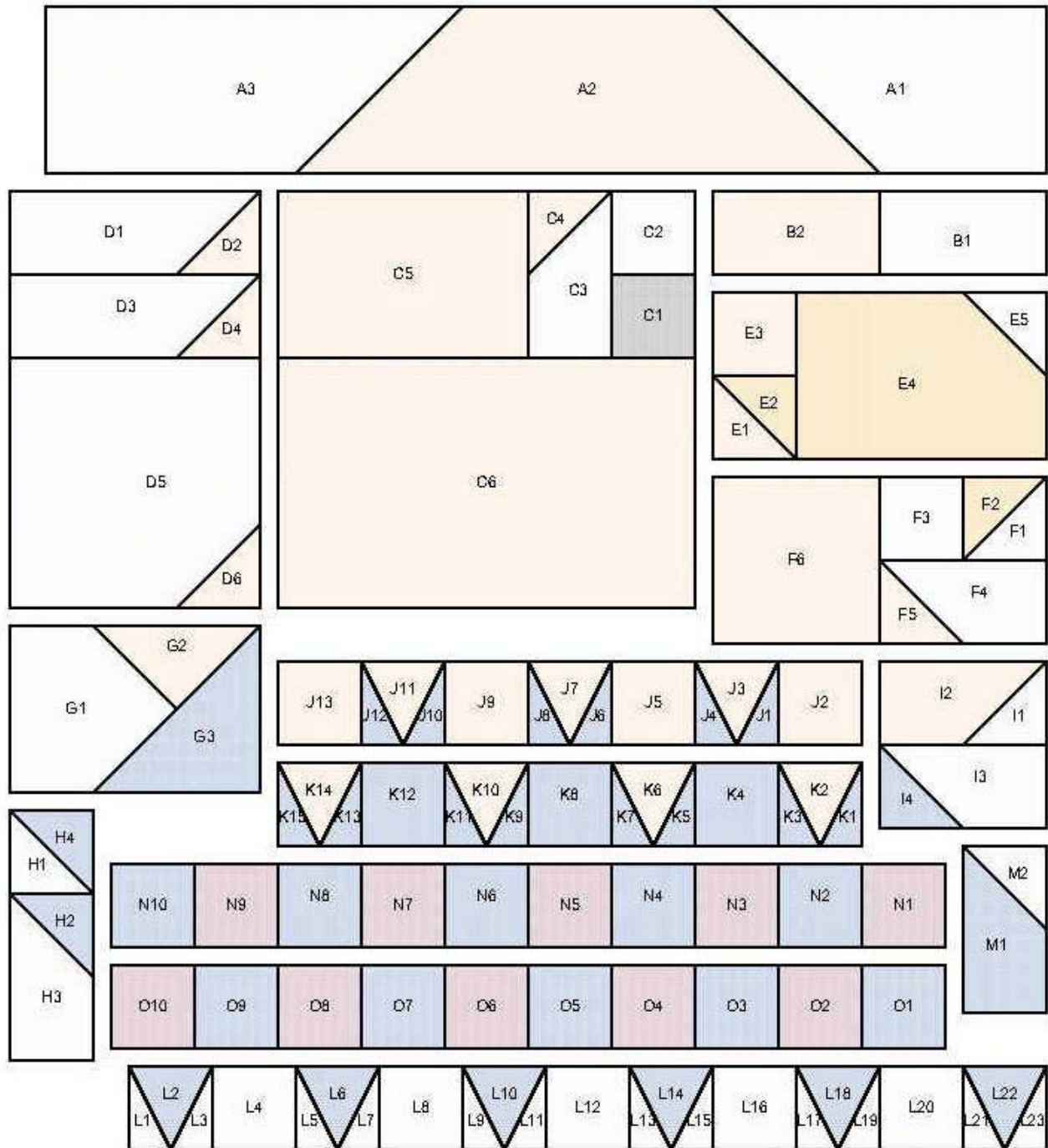
This is a blowup of the paper-piecing.

This eagle block uses paper-piecing, strip-piecing, & Peak & Spike Rulers.

Eagle Block Size is 24" square Finished size. The image below has been MIRRORED.



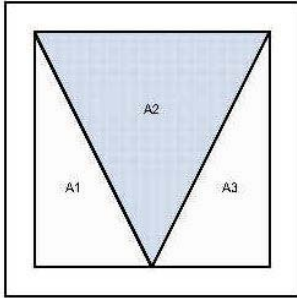

Sizes are approximate squares or rectangles cut sizes with a little extra wiggle room for *Paper-piecing*.

A1 - 9 1/2" x 5"	Background	G1 - 7 1/2" x 7"	background
A2 - 16" x 5"	Eagle Head	G2 - 5 1/2" x 3 1/2"	eagle head
A3 - 11" x 5"	Background	G3 - 5 1/4" x 5 1/4"	Eagle Body (blue)
B1 & B2 - 5" x 3"	1 ea. of Eagle head and background	H1 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	background
C1 & C2 - 3" sq.	1 black & 1 White eye	H2 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Eagle body (blue)
C3 - 3 1/2" x 5"	White eye	H3 - 5 1/2" x 3 1/2"	background
C4 - 3 1/2" sq.	Eagle head	H4 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Eagle body (blue)
C5 - 7" x 5"	Eagle head	I1 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	background
C6 - 11" x 7"	Eagle head	I2 - 3 1/2" x 5 1/2"	Eagle head
D1 & D3 - 6 1/2" x 3"	Background	I3 - 5 1/2" x 3 1/2"	background
D2, D4, & D6" - 3 1/2"	Eagle Head	I4 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Eagle Body (blue)
D5 - 7"	background	Sections J & K & L - Cut Squares 2 1/2" square (Exact size) Peaky & Spike ruler for "V" sections. (I use the Multi-size Peaky & Spike Set by Marti Michell)	
E1 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Eagle head	MAKE SURE you add the extra height of your strips according to the directions on your ruler. See next page for directions.	
E2 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Beak		
E3 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Eagle head		
E4 - 6 1/2" x 4 1/2"	Beak		
E5 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	background		
F1 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	background	M1 - 5 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Eagle Body (blue)
F2 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Beak	M2 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	background
F3 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	background	Sections N & O - Strip Pieced.	
F4 - 5" x 3"	background	Cut one 2 1/2" blue and one red strip across WOF.	
F5 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"	Eagle head	Sew along length. Cut into cross sections (10) 2 1/2".	
F6 - 5" x 5"	Eagle head	Sew these strip-sets together alternating colors.

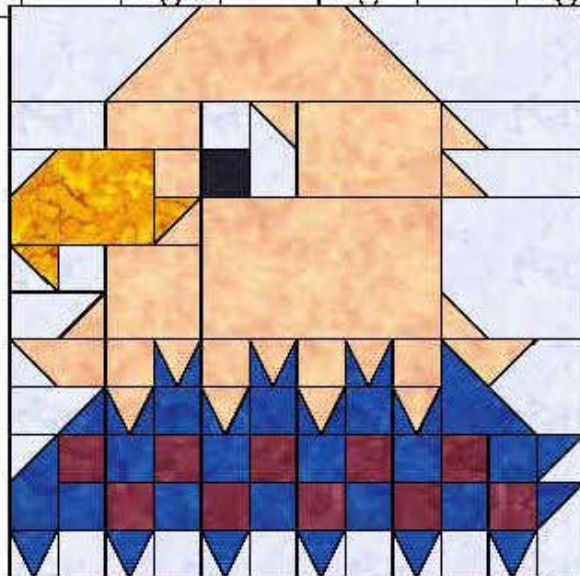
Note: the image to the left is NOT to scale. See the actual pattern in a separate file if you wish to paper-piece. You can paper-piece if you do not have the Peak & Spike ruler set.

Make 7 with the “V” or Peak section in eagle head fabric and the Sides or Spike sections in Blue. Cut the Peak section 2” on your ruler. If strip cutting these pieces, add the extra that your ruler recommends. My ruler says to cut the Peak section 1/2” wider if in strips. The peaky portion should be cut on the 2” line and if cutting in strips, add 5/8” wider strips. Cutting in strips, allows you to rotate and/or flip the ruler to save fabric.

Make an additional 6 with the “V” or peaky section in blue and the sides or spike sections in background fabric.

Cut an additional 2 1/2” squares (exact size) 4 in eagle head fabric, 3 in Blue, and 5 in background fabric. Sew together between the (PeakSpike) sections as shown on the blowpart on page 2.

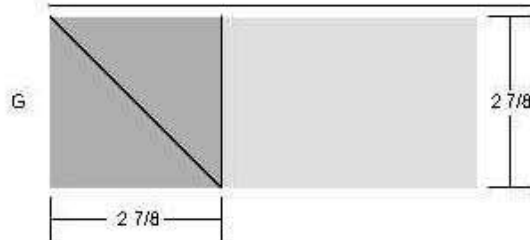
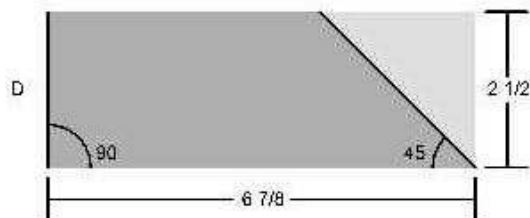
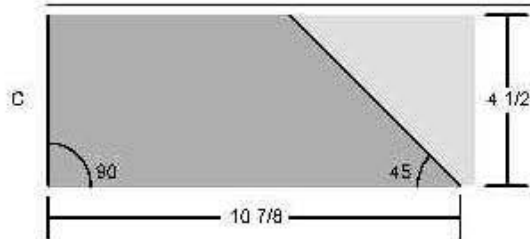
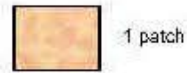
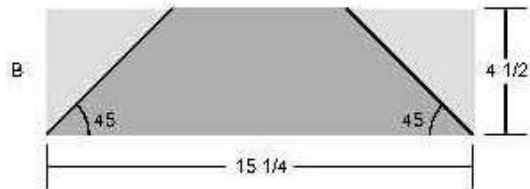
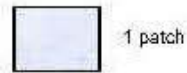
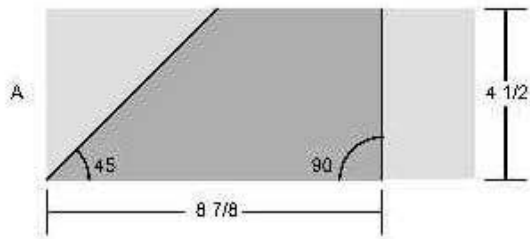
On the following pages are the rotary cutting measurements for those who wish to use them. Please note, the diagram for rotary cutting does NOT match that of the one used for paper-piecing on page 1 & 2. Also, when a section can not be rotary cut, it is not included in the rotary cutting charts. These sections have to be cut and sewn using a different method. For example “F” can not be rotary cut and should be paper-pieced along with “P & Q” sections. There is a file separate from the main paper-piecing pattern that has just these sections. Also note when using the rotary cutting, no extra fabric has been added to the measurements. Cut accurately, and sew with a 1/4” seam allowance.



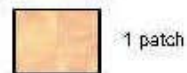
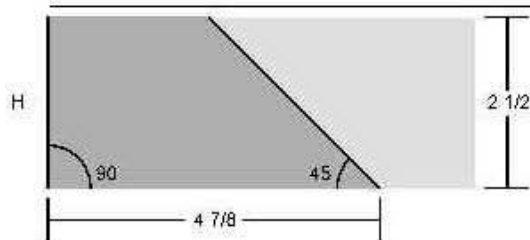

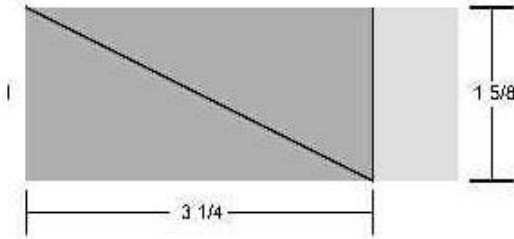
Patch Count
