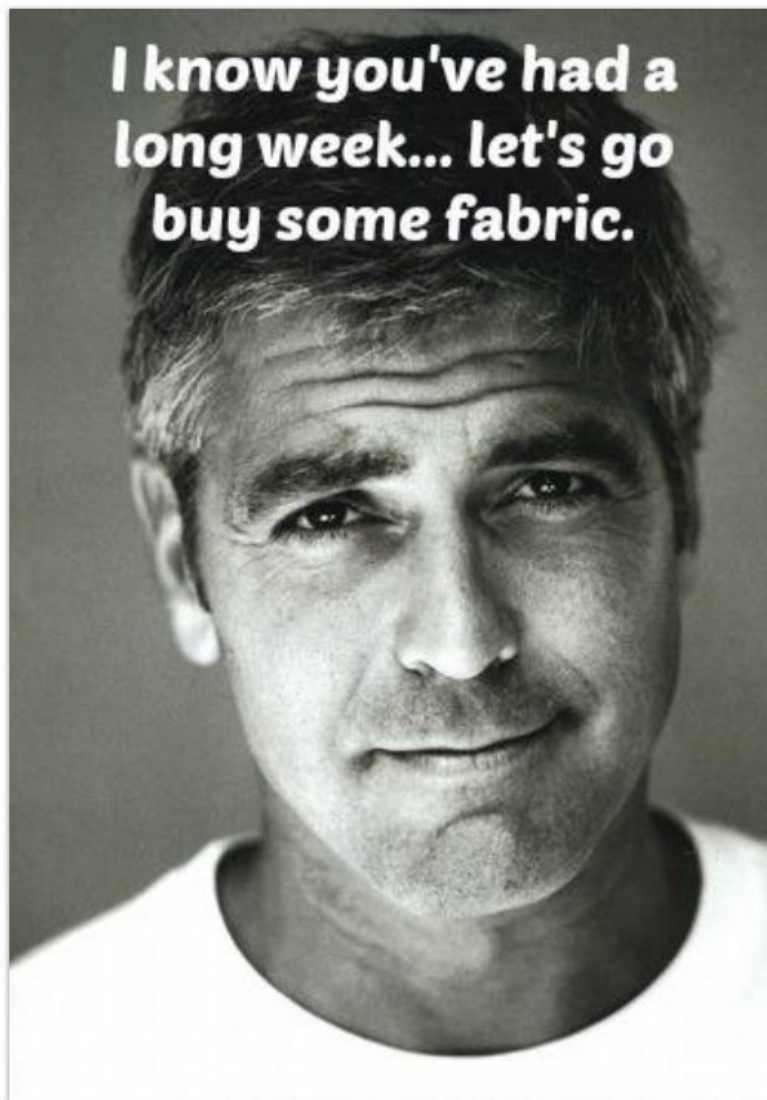

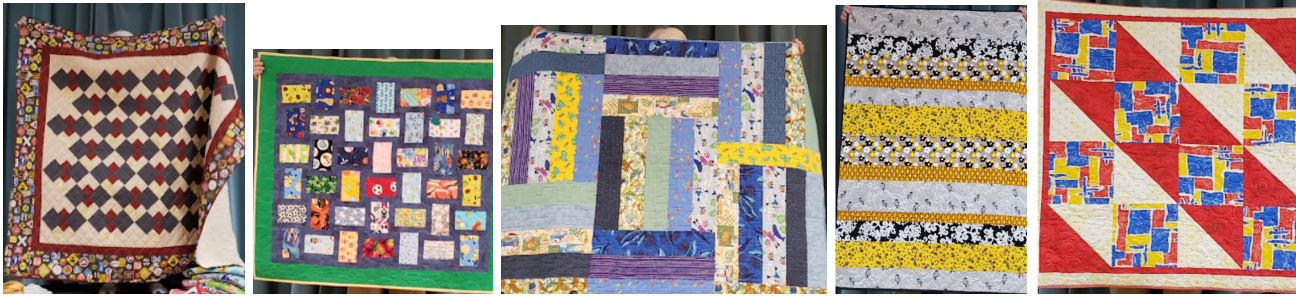
## June 2023 Patchwords
