We adapted this great pattern to use with flannel at our service day activity. This pattern lends itself well to the envelope method of finishing quilts because the finished top measures about the same size as the width of the flannel.

Here are the changes we made:

- Instead of a narrow border and a wide border, we cut four strips at 5 inches for a single border. I don't like to cut flannel smaller than 3 1/2 inches.
- We pieced the four patch units from the donated scraps already cut into 3 1/2" squares. These were scrappy and mismatched for the most part, but by using a solid, constant fabric for the 6 1/2 inch alternating squares, it calms it down and gives a unified look.
