

Zermatt Resort Nov. 12 – 15, 2025



Pumpkin Party!



We tied one large and 5 small quilts at our pumpkin party. We ate pumpkin seeds, pumpkin spice flavored tootsie rolls and M&Ms, Brownie cookies with pumpkin spice chips, and pumpkin chili.





The chili was delicious! Here is the easy recipe:

Creamy Turkey Pumpkin Chili

1 lb ground turkey

1 can (15 oz) pumpkin puree

1 can (15 oz) cannellini beans, drained and rinsed

1 can (14.5 oz) diced tomatoes

1 cup chicken broth

1 medium onion, chopped

2 cloves garlic, minced

1 tablespoon chili powder

1 teaspoon cumin

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/4 teaspoon black pepper

1 cup heavy cream

Fresh cilantro for garnish

Instructions

In a large pot, brown the ground turkey over medium heat until fully cooked.

Add the chopped onion and minced garlic, cooking until the onion is translucent.

Stir in the pumpkin puree, cannellini beans, diced tomatoes, chicken broth, chili powder, cumin, salt, and black pepper.

Bring the mixture to a simmer and let it cook for about 20 minutes, stirring occasionally.

Stir in the heavy cream and cook for an additional 5 minutes.

Serve hot, garnished with fresh cilantro.


